Firms in tier 1 and tier 2

"French-style" law firm Armengaud Guerlain punches above its weight in IP litigation. Its team, which includes three partners, is widely respected by peers. One describes it as "a very serious firm". Name partner Stéphane Guerlain and IP Star Catherine Mateu are picked out as the two prominent soft IP specialists. "Guerlain is experienced in acting for luxury brands," says one peer. Another adds: "He is a great lawyer." Mateu is said to be "a well-known figure" in IP litigation.

The firm recently represented clients such as L'Oréal, Comigel and Regent Hotel in trade mark disputes.

Bird & Bird is Managing IP's Europe Firm of the Decade. Its IP team in France comprises five partners and 11 associates led by IP Star Yves Bizollon. All the partners are based in the Paris office.

IP Stars Nathalie Ruffin and Rebecca Delorev are endorsed by peers for contentious soft IP matters. One peer says: "I know Nathalie and Rebecca mostly handle trade mark and design work. They have a lot of associates. They are serious opponents." For IT-related IP matters, the team can count on the expertise of Marc Schuler.

The French IP agency Cabinet Beau de Loménie has offices in Paris, Lyon, Marseille and Lille, in addition to branches in Germany and the UK. In total it has more than 200 IP professionals. Its trade mark department is headed by the "active" IP Star Aurélia Marie. "It is a large firm with a foreign client base," says one commentator.

The team is respected and trusted. "We won't mind referring work to them," says a rival. One partner from 299,973

a top-tier law firm likes the firm for its "reliability".

Cabinet Escande is an IP boutique based in Paris. It has four lawyers including name partner and IP Star Michel-Paul Escande. Peers single him out for praise in contentious matters. "He is quite inventive and handson." Luxury industry and anti-counterfeiting specialist Claire Herissay-Ducamp is now at law firm Candé Blanchard Ducamp.

Cabinet Gilles Vercken is particularly known for advising clients in the creative industries on copyright and related matters. The firm last year welcomed IT lawyer Eléonore Varet as a partner. The core IP/TMT team now consists of three partners, three associate lawyers and two expert consultants. The team is led by

the preeminent copyright expert and name partner Gilles Vercken. He is supported by IP Star Florence Gaullier.

The firm has strong links with the academic community. It announced the Cabinet Gilles Vercken Doctoral Thesis Award last year in collaboration with the Institut de Recherche en Propriété Intellectuelle.

Cabinet Plasseraud is one of the biggest prosecution firms in France, with five offices nationwide. Peers admire its work as well as business strategy. "They have an innovative way of working as well as better pricing, I would refer clients to them if conflicted," says one. IP Star and partner Guylène Kiesel Le Cosquer is named as a leading trade mark practitioner.

Casalonga is an IP group made up of a team of patent and trade mark attorneys, and a team of lawyers. It has three offices in France in addition to branches in Germany and Spain. In France the firm offers IP filing and prosecution services through Casalonga & Associés, while its lawyers at Casalonga Avocats handle contentious IP matters. "They have a reputation in trade marks," says one rival.

The firm last year recorded a number of successful oppositions before the French IP Office and the OHIM for clients such as CBS Interactive and BSkyB. It also represented Beats Electronics before the Court of Paris in a trade mark infringement and unfair competition claim against ALEYPO Design.

Arnaud Casalonga and Karina Dimidjian-Lecomte are the most prominent trade mark practitioners in the team. Nadège Parfait, who became a partner this year, is one to watch.

Cousin & Associés is a Paris-based IP litigation firm headed by IP grandee *Pierre Cousin*. Cousin works alongside three other partners and two associates. Although peers praise the whole team, IP Star Myriam Moatty is particularly mentioned as the prominent trade mark litigator. One commentator suggests that "the firm should be ranked in tier 1".

One competitor admires the "hands-on approach" taken by the partners in clients' work. The firm is also seen as flexible. "We would refer work to them as they are able to offer services at different price points," says one partner in a top-tier rival firm.

Trade mark case studies include representing the German retailer Roland in proceedings brought against it by Christian Louboutin, and Champagne Louis Roederer against a Spanish company selling sparkling wine under the 'Cristalino' mark.

Richemont are some of the brand owners it represents.

Sole practitioner Nicolas Boespflug is a respected copyright lawyer. Peers know him for representing big names in the music industry. "He represented Universal Music Group," says one.

Peers also rate the "excellent" copyright practice at Paris-based law firm NomoS. "They handle significant copyright cases." The three partners in its IP/TMT team are all IP lawyers with a focus on the creative industries. They are supported by a team of associate lawyers and legal assistants. Entertainment and internet specialist Eric Lauvaux stands out. One peer says: "Eric does a lot of work in the media and copyright space."

Novagraaf is a pan-European prosecution firm with 14 offices across five countries. In France it employs 16 trade mark specialists including lawyers and qualified rrade mark attorneys. Commentators were, however, not as generous with their praise though Olivier Boland is held in high regard.

Regimbeau has seven offices nationwide and a team of around 200 IP professionals. The firm attracted significant support for its top-tier status. "They are an established serious firm," says one commentator. "They have good clients and deliver a quality service."

The trade mark department is headed by IP Star Evelyne Roux alongside recently promoted Olivier Prats. Partner Martine Bloch-Weill is also named by peers as one of the leading trade mark practitioners in

Santarelli has a "very nice reputation". "We like to work with them," says one partner in a top-tier law firm. The firm has offices in Paris, Marseille and Toulouse and employs over 100 IP professionals. IP Stars Eric Le Bihan is a renowned specialist in the trade mark team; Hélène Lecornu also gets a mention. The team advises top French brand owners such as Kering and Rémy Martin.
